LEGISLATION SIGNED INTO LAW

AB 354 – Sacramento Regional Transit: Board of Directors Membership – Authorizes the City of Elk Grove to appoint an additional member to the Sacramento Regional Transit Board of Directors to ensure fair representation relative to Elk Grove’s new population size

AB 386 – California Right to Financial Privacy Act: Fraud Investigations – Protects dependent and older adults from financial abuse by extending the time period that financial abuse investigators can request records that can aid the identification of regular vs fraudulent spending patterns

AB 946 – Emergency Services: Endangered Missing Advisory – Adds California Highway Patrol’s existing Endangered Missing Advisory Alert (EMA) response notification system, which issues coordinated alerts with respect to people at risk, developmentally disabled, cognitively impaired, or who have been abducted, to the California code of laws in order to safeguard the future of the program

AB 1646 – Physician and Surgeon Postgraduate Training: Guest Rotations – Allows out-of-state medical residents to perform guest rotations for up to 90 days which will provide our nation’s future physicians and surgeons the opportunity to receive invaluable training in comprehensive reproductive and pregnancy care, since almost half of OB-GYN residency programs are in states that have enacted or are likely to enact abortion bans

ACR 12 – Trisomy Awareness Month - Trisomy is the presence within a person’s cells of a single extra chromosome, yielding a total of three chromosomes instead of a pair. As a type of aneuploidy, trisomy can occur with any of the 23 pairs of chromosomes individuals have. The legislature declared the month of March 2023 as Trisomy Awareness Month in California and commends this observation to all of our citizens.

ACR 13 – California Science and Technology Week – This bill designated the week of February 13, 2023 to February 17, 2023 as California Science and Technology Week. California is home to some of the nation’s most distinguished research and higher education institutions on the state’s behalf, including the University of California system. Official recognition of the importance and value of science and technology to California will enhance awareness and support for those activities.

HR 5 – Lunar New Year – January 22, 2023 marks the beginning of the Lunar New Year, which is celebrated in many Asian communities around the world, including in the United States and especially in California. The Lunar New Year is predominately celebrated by the 2,500,000 Chinese, Korean, Vietnamese, and Lu-Mien residents of California. The Legislature joined Asian and Pacific Islander communities throughout the state in celebrating January 22, 2023 as the beginning of the Lunar New Year.

HR 45 – Probation Professionals Appreciation – Probation professionals play a unique and essential role in our justice system and communities. Probation officers are trained experts prepare to manage trauma and other needs of system-involved individuals and safely connect them to the supports they need to successfully transition back to our communities. The Assembly proclaimed July 16, 2023 to July 22, 2023 as Probation Services Week.

Assembly District 10 Budget Accomplishments

Regional Active Shooter and Human Trafficking Training Center

- **Secured \$1 million** in funding to upgrade an existing law enforcement training center in Sacramento County to accommodate training for active shooter threats and the extraction of victims of human trafficking

Greenhaven Soccer Club Soccer Fields

- **Secured \$1.35 million** to renovate and make safety improvements to three soccer fields that the Greenhaven Soccer Club and surrounding community rely upon, at Garcia Bend Park in Sacramento

Meadowview Community Mental Health Support Center

- **Secured \$300,000** in funding for needed accessibility improvements to the Health Education Councils newly acquired building in South Sacramento that will function as a mental health support center. The improvements will include installation of an elevator from the first floor to the second floor as well as installation of solar powered electric vehicles charging stations in the parking lot

Parkway Elementary School Outdoor Eating and Learning Shade Structure

- **Secured \$750,000** in funding for Parkway Elementary School, which is located in a heat island without a single shade structure, for an outdoor eating and learning shade structure that includes tables and benches

Elk Grove Regional Veterans Memorial Wall

- **Secured \$100,000** in state assistance to the Cosumnes Community Services District for the completion of construction of the Elk Grove Regional Veterans Memorial Wall

Meadowview Community Farmers Market

- **Secured \$500,000** in funding for the city of Sacramento to complete and launch the Meadowview Community Farmer's Market to increase access to fresh and healthy foods in low-income South Sacramento, on an ongoing basis
